

We welcome you to 'Rebel Girls,' our 18th annual dance recital, and our homage to women, past and present, who paved a way for all in the face of adversity. The show presents their powerful and inspiring stories, all set to the enchanting tunes of Indian classical & world music in six different languages. The first act will showcase pure Bharatanatyam, a dance form that originated in the temples of India and dates back 3,000 years. The second act will focus on Navanritya, a newer contemporary synthesis of various Indian classical dances, including Western ballet, yoga, folk dances, and martial arts. This style was created by Anwesha's Gurus, the late Dr. Manjushri Chaki-Sircar and Dr. Ranjabati Sircar. This act features two dance dramas: Chitra: Princess Warrior and Moana. At NNDA and Ray of Hope International, we stress these important themes in our world through dance, music and poetry.
